
DREW'S CAPE LIST (w/ Bob's Addendum)

FOOD

WELLFLEET:

- Some of the best clamshacks (in order of my preference): Moby Dick, Mac's at the pier, PJ's
- Mac's Shack (Commercial Street) is very good.
- Winslow's Tavern is good.
- Wicked Oyster has good breakfasts.
- Flying Fish for lunch or baked goods.
- Sunbird Food truck is very good--if you are in Orleans their restaurant is excellent.
- PB Boulangerie has amazing bakery. Real croissants, the breads are excellent, particularly the Farmers and the fromage et lardon. Dinner and lunch are ok. Some people rave about dinner.

TRURO:

- Blackfish is the best restaurant in Truro. Great food and atmosphere
- Terra Luna. Very good food, nice atmosphere
- Chequessett Chocolates are very good and you can get a cup of chocolate there, a bit like Mexico. Friends have told me that Salty's Market almost next door is good and has good sandwiches but haven't tried it yet. Not much else in Truro.

PROVINCETOWN:

- The Mews is about the best on the outer Cape.
- Front Street is very good.
- Bubala's is ok for lunch.
- Ross's Grill is good.
- Mac's Seafood is good.
- Squealing Pig is good for lunch or a drink.
- Devon's is pretty good.

THINGS TO DO – between eating

- Wellfleet Beaches: Ocean – Maguire Landing (easiest access), White Crest (best waves). Bay-side: Duck Harbor (beautiful, not crowded), Mayo Beach (next to marina, restaurants, kid friendly)
- Truro Beaches: Ballston Beach and Longnook are amazing (limited to Truro guests or off-season)
- Kayak the Herring River, Pamet River, Wellfleet Harbor to Great Island
- Modern House tour--Truro and Wellfleet (and P-town) have lots of modernist houses. Many of the greats (Breuer, Saarinen, Chermayeff, Charles Jencks, etc.) summered here and built interesting homes for themselves, family and clients, plus local architects that were pretty good. Many are in the Wellfleet Woods on the Truro/Wellfleet line around the ponds. Biking on these sand roads is great. The tours are only a few times a summer and tickets go quickly. There's a book, Cape Cod Modern by Peter McMahon et al that is well worth reading and might help you find them. Peter is a local architect that heads the Cape Cod Modern House Trust, who give the tours.
- Biking the sand roads.
- Our kids like to go to the Beachcomber for music in the evening.
- The Harbor Stage Company on the Wellfleet waterfront is an amazing small company. A Doll's

House earlier this summer was the best we've ever seen! It's a must.

- Wellfleet Harbor Actors Theater can be good.
- Payomet sometimes has good performers.
- There's a classical music series performing at various venues on the Cape that is Very Good.

BOB'S ADDENDUM

- Best lobster roll (up for debate): in Rock Harbor, Orleans – Young's Fish Market--also Sir Crickets and Land Ho in Orleans
- Boat rental – sailing or outboard motor (Wellfleet Harbor): Wellfleet Marine
- Whale watching tour: P-town from the piers (several companies)
- Walks: Wellfleet: Great Island trail walk, uncle Tim's bridge. P-town: Race point visitor center--any thing in the Provincelands section of national seashore.
- Lighthouses: Race Point (great walk-beautiful setting), Highland (Truro - e-z to visit)-historic museum nearby is interesting.
- Flea Market: best ever at the So. Wellfleet Drive-in – Sunday mornings
- Drive-in Movie: only one – So. Wellfleet
- Audubon Wildlife Sanctuary: So. Wellfleet
- Putt-putt golf: many along Rt 6 – maybe best, but crowded – Arnolds in Eastham
- Deep sea fishing: Charter boat for up to six out of Rock Harbor in Orleans. Striped bass and bluefish. Usually do half day trip. Also go after tuna but requires whole day, expensive.
- Surfing: White Crest Beach best for Wellfleet – rent boards at sickbay in Wellfleet village or Jack's Boat Rental on Rt 6, Wellfleet. Best in Truro: Longnook and Ballston, the latter looks particularly good this year.
- Ponds: many to explore —great for after a hot beach afternoon. Gull pond in Wellfleet has hourly canoe/kayak/paddle boat rentals, a dock with life guards.
- Preservation Hall (Main St in Wellfleet Village) has a good year-around program of lectures, films, and performances.
- Wellfleet Library is a few blocks farther down Main St –a terrific library and a good lecture series as well. Great childrens' room and activity center.
- Castle Hill Arts Center (Truro) has workshops, classes and studio space.
- Wellfleet Recreation Center (Mayo Beach) has tennis courts, skateboard park, and playground – also runs summertime kids programs. Shakespear @ Mayo Beach – July & August on Mondays and Tuesdays. Also, Square Dancing on the end of the Wellfleet pier Wednesday nights at 7:00.
- Golf and sailing lessons at Chequessett Yacht & Country Club (Wellfleet). Also, sailing lessons in Wellfleet Harbor with Outer Cape Sailing.
